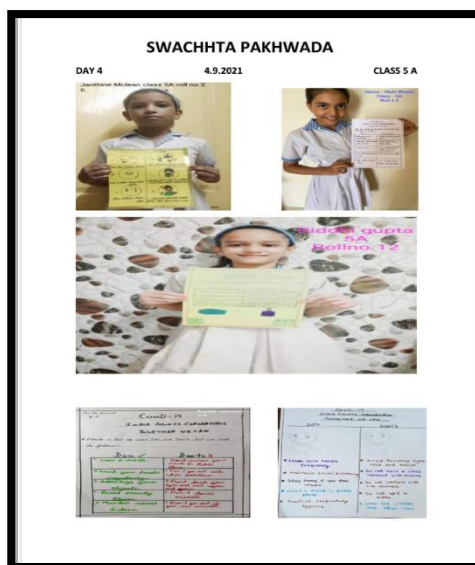


## SWACHHTA PAKHWADA

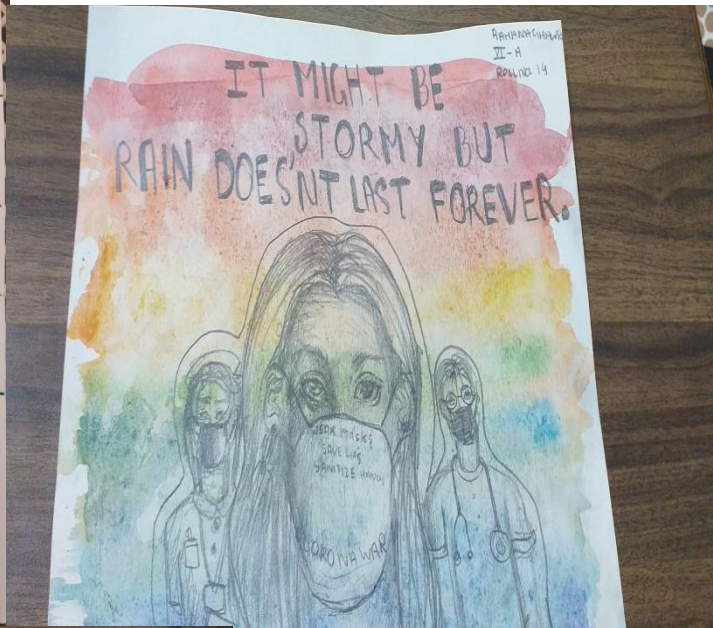
These activities reminded them to be responsible citizens and to use the resources of nature judiciously.



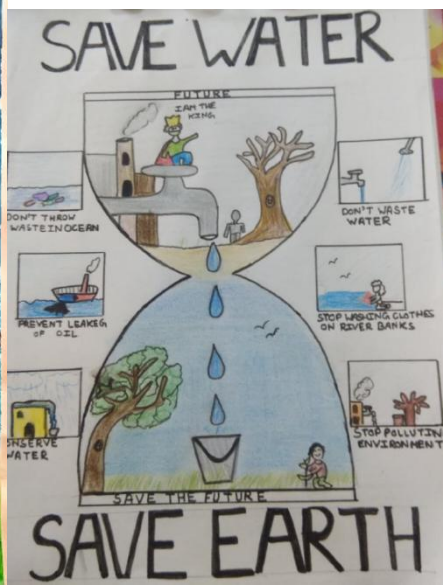
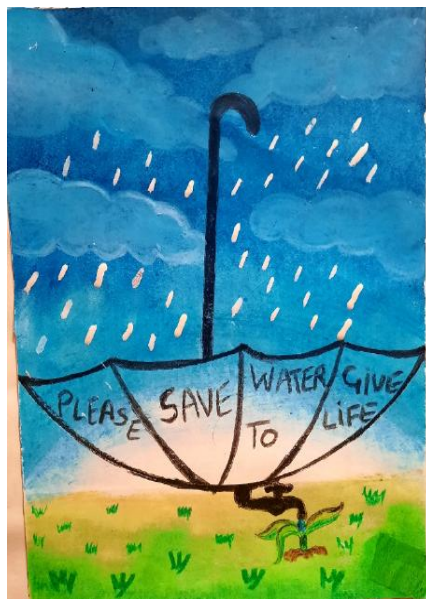


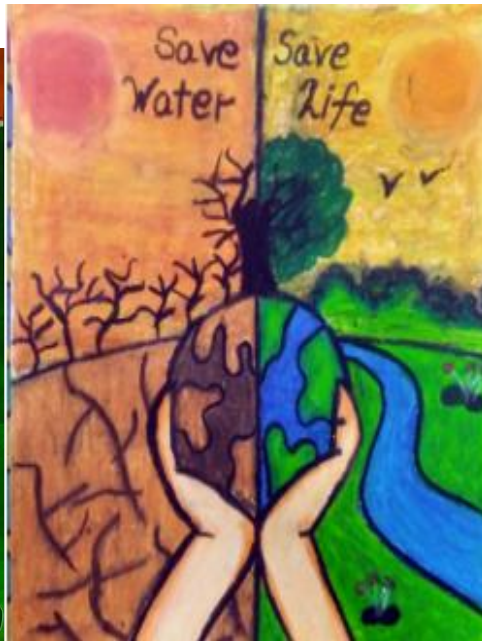
